



CDT BINGO

Greet another hiker! If they are going uphill, yield to them.	Look at a tree. Do you know what kind of tree it is?	Count! How many miles did you hike? How many kilometers is that?	Spot a bird	Pause! Imagine: What would it be like to hike on this trail for over five months?
Stop! Shh. Identify 3 sounds that you can hear.	Bring and drink water	Spot a mammal, small or large	Leave No Trace: Observe a cool rock but do not move it!	Look at the hike you will do on a map.
Which way does water flow? Pause during your hike and see which way falling rain would flow.	Keep your feet happy! Wear safe footwear.	Visit the CDT!	Stick to the marked trail	Spot a reptile or amphibian
Sing a song	Stay safe from the sun! Wear sunscreen or a hat	Pack a snack or lunch	Plan ahead: check the weather before you hike	Spot three geographic landforms. Think: mountain, desert, valley, plateau, etc.
Spot an animal track or dropping	Spot an insect	Be safe! Tell someone where your family will be hiking and when you will be back.	Research! What is the history of the land where you're hiking?	Find your way! Bring a navigational device.
